Notes

1. The early bird deadline for the Chinese New Year meeting is 12 noon May 25, 2020 via our online registration system.
2. Parking is available at 44 St. Joseph (East of Bay St.) for \$5 after 6 pm plus \$3.50 per half-hour prior to 6 pm. The parking lot is a shared residence and business lot beneath the restaurant. After parking your car, take the business (1033 Bay Street) elevator to the ground level lobby, exit the front door and turn right for the restaurant. The business elevator is located near the garage entrance.
3. Via TTC, take the Bay bus north from the Financial District or south from Bay Station and get off at St. Joseph Street. The location at 1033 Bay Street is 1 block north of Wellesley or 2 blocks south of Bloor. During rush hours, it may be faster to walk from Bay Station or walk from Wellesley Station, as the Bay buses tend to bunch up and travel at a snail's pace.
4. All attendees will be members of the Club for 2020 and be entitled to discounts for events for the rest of 2020.
5. University students must show a valid student's ID at the door for a \$15 refund.
